City of Tempe Bulk Trash Pick Up Schedule 2024

January - 29 - 26 March - 25 - 29 May - 27 - 31 July - 29 - Aug 2 September - 30 - Oct 4 December - 2 - 6

- Do not place items out for collection any earlier than ten days prior to your collection week.
- All items must be placed for collection <u>no later</u> than 6:00 a.m. on the Monday of your collection week.
- Place uncontained garbage and green organics into two separate piles, at least four feet apart.

Architectural Changes

STREET PARKING

Per our CC&R's, vehicles should be kept in garages and driveways before parking on the street. Crowding on the street has caused several near miss accidents. Please keep vehicles off the streets, especially at Night.





SPEED LIMITS

When driving thru the community, please adhere to the posted speed limit of 20 MPH over the Speed Bumps and 25 MPH all other times.

TRASH

Trash containers must be covered at all times and Should NOT be visible from the street, except on trash collection day and then only for the shortest time reasonably necessary to allow for collection.
